

## COVID-19 TEST RESULT: **POSITIVE**



### Test Notes

Your coronavirus test result is positive. This means that you probably have the virus. Even if you have not had symptoms of coronavirus you must now self-isolate for 10 days from the day after your test date.

You must obtain, take and return a free follow up polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test from NHS Test and Trace to confirm this. You can obtain your confirmatory PCR test by visiting [www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test](http://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test) or by calling 119.

This test will be free of charge and will be sent to you as a home test kit.

You must take this test in accordance with this notice. If this confirmatory test is negative, you no longer need to self-isolate.

You may be contacted for contact tracing and to check that you, and those who you live or are travelling with, are self-isolating.

You must not travel, including to leave the UK, during self-isolation.
